REPORT

1. On 27 October 2006 the Tribunal made Determination 1 of 2006, covering the entitlements (other than basic salary) of members of the House of Assembly in their various capacities.
2. That Determination and its covering Report has been tabled in the Assembly and, to the extent that it is not disallowed, will become effective in April, with retrospective application to 31 October 2006.
3. The Determination omitted to set a daily rate of travelling allowance for Perth. This would mean that members travelling to Perth and who elect to use travelling allowance rather than cost reimbursement to meet their expenses would be entitled to the "Elsewhere in Australia" rate.
4. The Administrator has formally requested the Tribunal to set a travelling allowance rate for Perth.
5. Having regard to the maximum unsubstantiated expenses rates set by the Commissioner for Taxation for this financial year, and to the respective determination By the Commonwealth Remuneration Tribunal for Members of Parliament, the Tribunal has set a Perth rate at the same level as for Adelaide in the attached Determination 1 of 2007.
6. As this Determination amends the Determination now before the House, that new rate will be effective from the same date as the other travelling allowance rates.
