Register interest in a position on an NT Government board

Northern Territory Government (NTG) boards and committees play an important role in good governance. They provide an effective link between government and the community.

Individuals eligible for appointment to NTG boards include:

- Australian citizens;
- individuals granted permanent resident status;
- individuals with a visa that allows them to work in Australia, and their visa is valid for the term of appointment;
- New Zealand citizens with a Special Category visa that allows them to remain and work in Australia indefinitely; and
- NTPS employees can be appointed as a 'community' member, but will require approval to engage in what may be paid employment outside the employee's normal duties.

NTG boards and committees are established under legislation or by ministerial direction.

A list of statutory boards classified for remuneration purposes, is available on the [NTG Board Remuneration website](#). Legislation or Terms of Reference outline member information, including:

- qualifications or expertise required (e.g. lawyer, plumber, electrician, veterinarian);
- community representatives required (e.g. Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islanders, industry or local government representatives);
- number of meetings required; and
- their term of appointment.

As members of both NTG statutory and non-statutory bodies (whether paid through sitting fees or other entitlement, or unpaid) are likely to fall under the definition of a worker of the NT Government as per section 7 of the *Work Health and Safety (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2011*, you will be required to provide your COVID-19 vaccination status if appointed to an NTG board, in line with the Chief Health Officer Directions relating to the mandatory vaccinations of workers to attend a workplace [COVID-19 Directions \(No. 55\) 2021](#) and [COVID-19 Directions \(No. 52\) 2022](#) (or as amended from time to time). This advice remains current until the 'Declaration of Public Health Emergency' dated 18 March 2020 ceases.

Submitting your registration does not guarantee appointment to a board, and indicates your agreement to your resume/CV being accessible to all NTG agencies for this purpose only.
